

READING GROUP GUIDE

The following questions can enhance your group's reading of D. J. Green's *No More Empty Spaces,* or ask your own. Good reading!

- 1. How did this narrative's the multiple points of view enrich the reading experience for you?
- 2. Have you ever been to Turkey? What did you learn about Turkey from this novel? Does a setting in another country increase your interest in a story?
- 3. Much of this book is about geology and how it affects our daily lives. Did the book change how you think about that? Discuss.
- 4. Do you think what Will did, taking his children to Turkey, can be characterized as "kidnapping" (since his ex-wife does not seem to care that he's taken them)? Is what he did best for the kids?
- 5. Paula is a feminist at a time when feminism was growing. How does she learn to chart her own course? Do you think she helps all the kids do the same? If so, how?
- 6. How do flying and sailing matter to the story, especially in a story that is so centered on the ground beneath us?
- 7. Why are Kevin's letters used in the novel?
- 8. What was your first impression of Will? Did that impression change over the course of the novel? Why?
- 9. Did the ending surprise you? Why?
- 10. How does this novel depict families?

- 11. This book began in the 1970s, which was not so long ago. Yet our world is vastly different now. Do you consider this book historical fiction? Why or why not?
- 12. A theme in this novel is control—of oneself, others, and of the world around us. What do the characters wrestle for control of, and how?
- 13. Another theme is integrity. In what ways do the characters' integrity affect the plot?
- 14. What does the title mean? How does it work for this novel?
- 15. How does the cover evoke themes from the novel?
